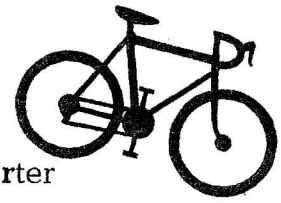

Definitions	Sentences
<b>monochrome</b> (adj) - one color	The blue, <u>monochrome</u> painting was boring.
<b>monopoly</b> (n) - control by one person or one company	Thomas Rich had a <u>monopoly</u> on all the real estate in the center of the city.
<b>unicorn</b> (n) - a horse-like animal with one horn	The fairy tale featured a young princess and her pet <u>unicorn</u> .
<b>unify</b> (v) - to make one	The king tried to <u>unify</u> all the small serfdoms into one strong kingdom.
<b>duplex</b> (n) - a house that has two separate units	Jorge lived in one of the <u>duplexes</u> and his friend Bryan lived next door.
<b>biennial</b> (adj) - happening every two years	The <u>biennial</u> celebration took place in even-numbered years.
<b>bilingual</b> (adj) - speaking two languages	Many people in Quebec are <u>bilingual</u> , speaking both English and French.
<b>trilogy</b> (n) - a group of three plays or books with a common theme	I have read all three books in the <u>trilogy</u> , but I like the first book best.
<b>triathlon</b> (n) - an athletic contest usually involving swimming, running and biking	She completed all three events in the <u>triathlon</u> in record time, winning the contest.
<b>quadrangle</b> (n) - a figure with four sides and angles	Squares and rectangles are examples of <u>quadrangles</u> .
