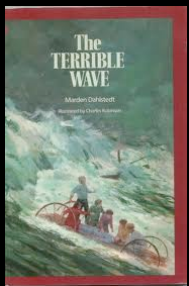
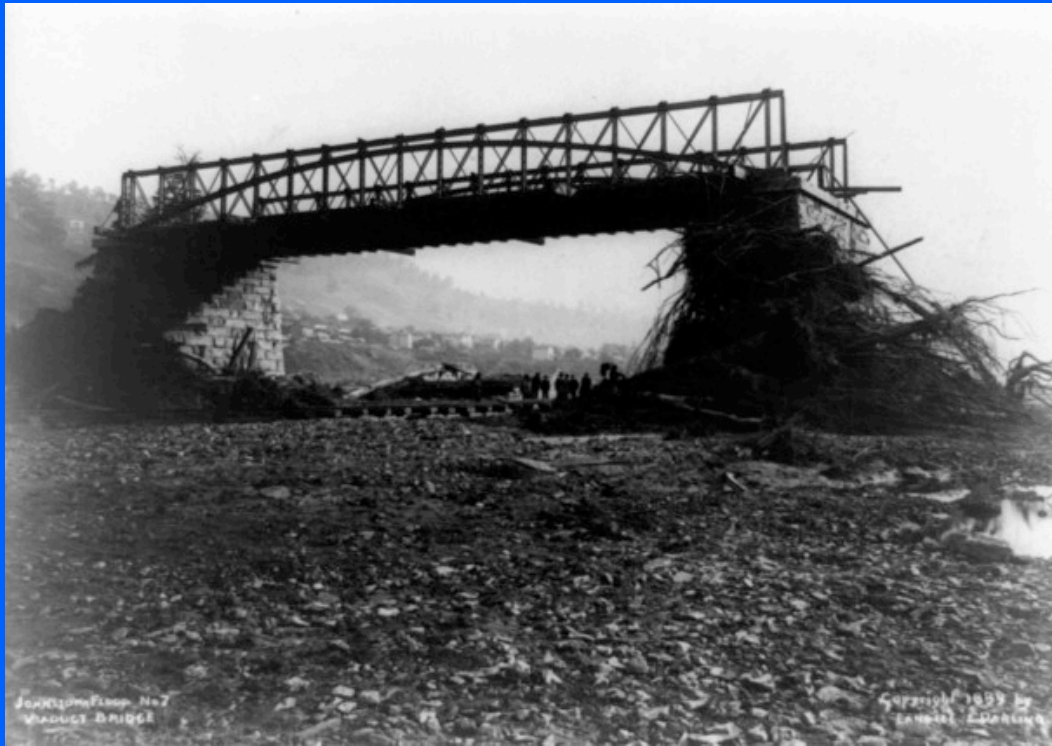


The Terrible Wave
