

The Terrible Wave

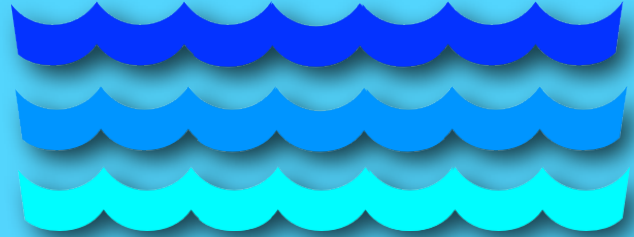
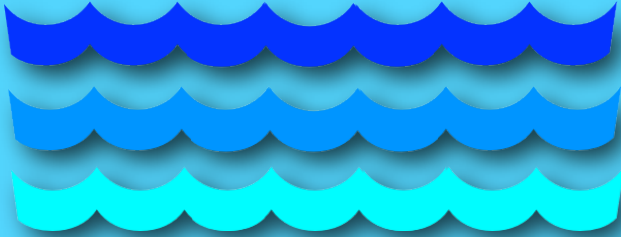
