

# THE TERRIBLE WAVE

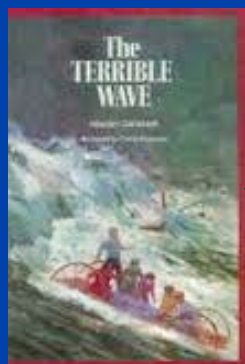

Floods were nothing new to the people in Johnstown, but this one was different. The last person who survives dies Thursday March 20, 1997 at Blattenberger's personal care home in Black Lick. He was 108 years old when he died. 99 entire families died including 396 children. The Johnstown Flood was one of the worst United States natural disasters.*

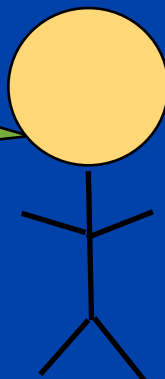
The book *The Terrible Wave* is a really exciting book! The book will keep you from being bored. The New Readers
