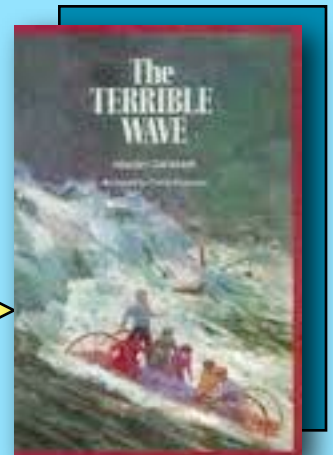
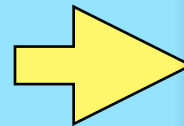


*Over two-thousand people were released from their bodies in the Johnstown Flood when the South Fork Dam broke at 3:10P.M. on May 31, 1889.*
