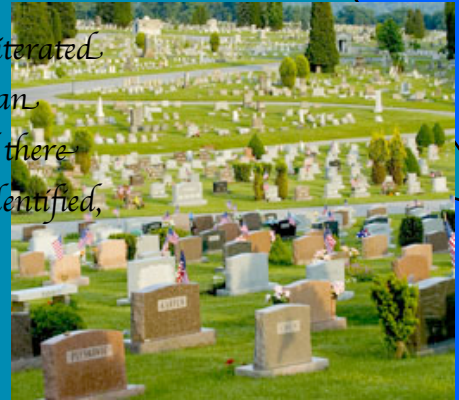


# The Terrible Wave
