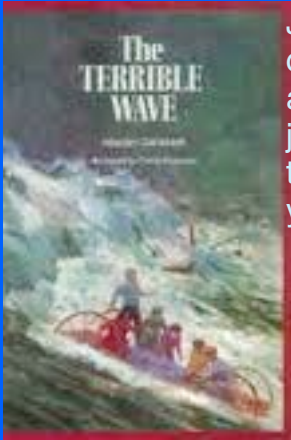


The Terrible Wave
